Standing Rules

1. A guest who is eligible for membership shall be limited to three visits in a fiscal year.
2. A *Founder's Day Celebration* shall be held every February 29th to commemorate the Chapter's founding on February 29, 1968.
3. In case of death:
 - a. the Treasurer shall send flowers when notified of the death of a member of the Chapter
 - b. The Corresponding Secretary shall send a note or card when notified of the death of a person in a member's immediate family.
4. Fees & Programs:
 - a. A guest speaker who does not charge a fee shall receive a check not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00).
 - b. Budgets for special programs and programs by members shall be approved in advance by the Board of Directors
 - c. Members who present Ikebana programs to other organizations will charge a fee of at least thirty five dollars (\$35.00), plus the cost of the flowers.
5. If a member accepts an invitation to exhibit, they must do so, or provide a substitute.
6. A Properties Chairperson shall be appointed who shall maintain a current inventory of all Chapter properties and their location.
7. At the end of tenure, the Treasurer shall be responsible for ordering an Ikebana pin, and/or a Past President's pin to be engraved on the back with initials, Chapter #132, and the date served.
8. To be eligible for membership, a new applicant must have had some Ikebana lessons or lessons in some related art.
9. Chapter #132 dues may be changed by action of the Board. (by precedent)
